BRIGHTSTAR LAVERTON TREATMENT OPERATIONS UPDATE

As part of the Department of Mines regular inspection procedures a prohibition notice was issued to Stone Resources Australia Limited requiring a plant cessation of production to rectify some problems, (particularly in the crusher area) that were not reported previously by the DMP. These issues were not addressed by previous site management and are now being addressed in an orderly manner.

It is expected that mill operations can recommence shortly and alternative short term crushing options are being investigated to minimise downtime.

Stone Resources Australia Limited is in continued discussion with the Department of Mines to resolve past issues and work together going forward.

Exploration drilling continues in the northern leases with preliminary assay results expected in several weeks on the first holes drilled .
